- All 9th grade scholars will need to be online M-T-TH-F at 7:40 for "Operation Bear Tracks" period.
- 10th, 11th, 12th grade scholars will follow the start time of their assigned remote learning schedule.
- All scholars will have a lunch break each day from 11:50 to 12:30
- Scholars will have a ten minute break between all classes. The school day will end at 2:30pm each day.

How Do I Get My Class Schedule?

The week before school starts students will be able to log into their ProgressBook account to see their schedule of classes. Please note this will not work accurately until week of September 1st.

Internet Access

The Youngstown City School District is providing basic home Internet access to scholars who do not have access for the 2020-2021 school year. This is basic access to the Internet for purposes of supporting our remote learning. Please understand that this access to the Internet is filtered to comply with the Children's Internet Protection Act (CIPA), which means some sites may be unavailable by using this program.

Technology/Meal ID Card Distribution

Beginning Aug 31st, the district will continue providing meals to scholars for the week. This will occur every Monday. The change is that each scholar will be given a "Meal ID Card" that must be scanned at the distribution site each week to receive meals. The Meal ID cards will be distributed to East students on Aug 31st and Sept 1.

Note: Door B5 which is located at the front of the building near the main entrance.

***Receiving Your Device (Chromebook):**

- The first step is to double check that you have received the second email that says the device is ready for pick up.
- Once you receive the email saying your device is ready for pickup you may come up to East on one of the following dates and times to pick it up: Monday, Aug 31st from (9:00am to 1:00pm) or from (4:00 to 7:00pm)/Tuesday, September 1st from (9:00am to 1:00pm) or from (4:00 to 7:00pm)
- Cars will line up along the sidewalk in near the main entrance of East High School, please stay in you car. You will be served curbside from the auxiliary gymnasium doors.

Please Note: A device cannot be distributed to a scholar until the online request is completed so families must wait until they receive the second email.

To request your device for pickup:

This first step is to go to Youngstown City Schools website to request the device: Families can go to www.ycsd.org, click the "About YCSD" tab and scroll down to "Remote Learning." From there, families can go to the "Devices" page, and click "Request My Scholar's Device." One request for a device must be submitted per YCSD scholar. There is also a link to submit the form in Spanish. After completing the request, the parent/guardian will get a confirmation email. A second email will be sent from YCSD when the request is completed.
